Subject: Moral Education	Year Group: 11
Week/Date	Focus/Topic
1 Sept 2 nd -5 th	 Baseline assessment for beginning of unit 'Ethics and Global Economy' based on the pillar of 'Character and Morality', following by an outline of curriculum orientation and expectations.
2 Sept 8 th -12 th	Define 'Global Economy' and 'Economic Globalisation'.
3 Sept 15 th -19 th	Outline the effect of 'Economic Globalisation' on income inequality within and between countries.
4 Sept 22 nd -26 th	 Put forward a reasoned and well-justified view on the value of fair trade as a way of reforming world trade in order to promote justice.
5 Sept 29 th -Oct 3 rd	Give an account of possible ethical consequences of their own consumer choices.
6 Oct 6 th -10 th	Explain what is meant by 'socially responsible investing'.
7 Oct 13 th -17 th	• End of unit assessment for pillar of 'Character and Morality' and to discuss how the potential options selected at GCSE's can impact your future.

11 Nov 10 th -14 th	 Explain and understand the factors that lead to addiction, including factors that influence people to start using addictive substances or form addictive habits

13 Nov 24 th -28 th	Demonstrate an awareness of the consequences of addiction on physical and mental health and ways in which people can be helped to overcome addiction
14 Dec 1 st -5 th	End of unit assessment for pillar of 'The Individual and Community'.
15 Dec 8 th -12 th	Baseline assessment for new unit 'Intercultural Relationships, based on the pillar of 'Cultural Studies'.
