Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

In our second half of term one we will be focusing on how to be a good friend by sharing and taking turns. We will be learning how to regulate our emotions when we feel upset and/or angry. We will also be learning how to become more independent by completing simple tasks set by our teachers, and continuing to tend to our own needs such as eating and toileting.

Communication and Language:

We will continue to develop our speaking and listening skills by using simple sentences when we speak and learning to take turns in conversation. We will also learn new vocabulary related to our topics and story books. We will practice using this vocabulary in the correct context. We will learn how to respond correctly to and ask questions of our peers and teachers.

Physical Development:

We will continue to develop our gross and fine motor skills this half term by engaging in lots of activities which encourage us to make big movements with our bodies, particularly during our PE and outdoor learning times. We will also continue to develop our fine motor skills within the classroom to help us with our pencil grip and scissor skills.



GFS High Performance Learning



Minibeasts and Transport

Our focus for this term will be on Minibeasts and Transport. We will be looking at different types of minibeast and their habitats. We will look at the life cycles of different minibeasts such as frogs and butterflies. We will move on to then look at transport. We will compare different types of transport and discuss our own experiences of using these types of transport. We will observe the similarities and differences between different forms of transport, discussing our favourite and the reasons for this. We will also celebrate the UAE's 50th National Day, Flag Day and learn about Diwali.

Reading:

This term we will continue with Floppy's Phonics learning new sounds and tricky words. We will learn how to apply our Phonics skills to our reading when we are exploring books within our environment.

Writing:

We will put our Phonics learning into practice by applying it to our writing tasks during our self chosen activities. We will learn to write lists and labels. We will continue to practice our name writing and letter formation.

Mathematics:

Our focus this half term will be 2D and 3D shape. We will have opportunities to manipulate shapes, allowing us to develop our spatial reasoning. We will also start to look at one more and one less of given numbers within 5 to support our early calculation skills.

Understanding the World:

We will be building up our knowledge of the world around us by looking at minibeasts, transport, the seasons and different celebrations such as Flag Day, Diwali and UAE National Day. We will learn new vocabulary linked to these topics and practice using them in the correct context.

Expressive Arts and Design:

We will continue to develop our creative skills by learning how to use tools for a purpose, We will also practice our song for the Winter Concert.
