Term 3	10/04/23	Discursive Writing	Introduction to Discursive Writing	Learners will explore the key skills for discursive writing (such as DAFOREST) and the effects on the reader/audience.
	17/04/23	Discursive Writing	Hook	Learners will learn what a 'hook' is and why is it used in discursive writing. A range of examples will be shown for students to analyse the effect.
	24/04/23	Discursive Writing	Audience Engagement	A range of speeches will be shown to students to analyse with a key focus on the effect on the audience and techniques used to engage the audience.
	01/05/23	Discursive Writing	Counter-argument	Learners will look at the effect of including a counter-argument in discursive writing and why it is important to explore different perspectives.
	08/05/23	Discursive Writing	Closing Argument	Learners will focus on the importance of a closing argument and the skills to create an impressionable conclusion.
	15/05/23	Discursive Writing	Speech Writing	Learners will write their own speeches focusing on a key topic. Once they have written their speeches, learners will deliver it to the rest of the class for feedback.
	22/05/23	Discursive Writing	Response to Feedback	Learners will use their personalised feedback to improve their speeches.
	29/05/23	IGCSE Poetry	Introduction to IGCSE Poetry	Recap of poetic devices and an introduction to IGCSE poetry, focusing on the AOs, key skills and key themes.
	05/06/23	IGCSE Poetry	Search For My Tongue	Learners will analyse the poem 'Search For My Tongue' focusing on language, structure and form.
	12/06/23	IGCSE Poetry	Half-Caste	Learners will analyse the poem 'Half-Caste' focusing on language, structure and form.
	19/06/23	IGCSE Poetry	Poetry Comparison	Learners will focus on the skills of a poetry comparison. They will then create their own poetry comparison focusing on 'Half-Caste' and 'Search For My Tongue'
	26/06/23	IGCSE Poetry	Response to Feedback	Learners will use their personalised feedback to improve their poetry comparison.
03/07/23	IGCSE Poetry	Poem At Thirty-Nine	Learners will analyse the poem 'Poem at Thirty-Nine' focusing on language, structure and form.
