As geographers and historians we will: .

- Research a famous musical artist from the country and look at their career.

As mathematicians, we will:

- Develop understanding of place value
- Practice using the formal written methods for adding and subtracting 4-digit numbers.
- Solve multi step problems using both addition and subtraction.

As artists we will:

• Study landscape patterns in our art lessons.



As musicians we will:

• Look at the way sounds are produced and classified.

As scientists we will :

- Identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating
- Recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear
- Find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it and the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it
- Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.
