Take a trip back in time to the land of The Pharaoh's in Ancient Egypt. We will learn all about the fascinating lives of the Ancient Egyptians and how their lives are similar and different to our own lives today. We will look at the inventions from this time period that helped to build their civilisation. We will learn about the gruesome process of mummification and the importance of this to the Ancient Egyptians. We will also learn how the Ancient Egyptians used hieroglyphics to tell their stories and create our own codes and messages using hieroglyphics.





As writers we will:

Study Hatshepsut from 'Fantastically Great Women who made History' written by Kate Pankhurst to identify the features of a biography at text, word and sentence level. We will develop our writing skills using tools from 'The Writing Rainbow' with a sharp focus on the craft of constructing sentences using vocabulary of the genre as well as immersive experiences to generate ideas.



As readers we will:

**Explore our book, There's a Pharaoh in my Bath by Jeremy Strong in Guided reading.
Make inferences about a character's feelings, motives and intentions, justifying these inferences with evidence from the text.
Consider authorial intent and choice!**



As mathematicians, we will:

- Read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1 000 000 and determine the value of each digit..
- Round any number up to 1 000 000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10 000 and 100 000..
- Read Roman numerals up to 1000 (M) and recognize years written in Roman Numerals.
- Count forwards and backwards in steps of powers of 10 for any given number up to 1 000 000.
- Add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits, including using formal written methods (columnar addition and subtraction).



As scientists, we will:

Use knowledge of properties of materials to explain our understanding and plan investigations. We will look at why certain materials are used around the home and school depending on their properties and features that make them fit or unfit for a purpose.



In computing we will:

Focus on the importance of keeping ourselves safe online and develop our understanding of how technology must be used in the correct manner.



As historians we will:

Delve into the past using videos, websites and VR headsets to help develop our understanding of the Ancient Egyptian civilisation and their lives.



As art we will:

Improve our understanding and skills by focusing on the theme of "Landscape Artwork" We will;

- Demonstrate and apply our understanding of chromatic and achromatic values scale.
- Practice shading technique in chromatic and achromatic styles.
- Create the illusion of form with shading.
