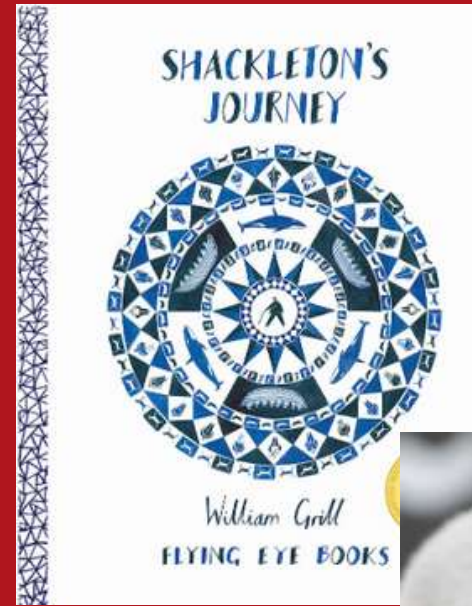

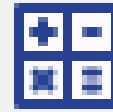
As writers, we will:

As readers, we will:

- Practise reading with great expression, showing awareness of the listener.
- Retrieve and record information from the text.
- Draw inferences about a character's thoughts, feelings and motives.
- Discuss and evaluate the authors use of language.
- Use evidence from the text to analyse character feeling.



As mathematicians, we will:

- Multiply and divide fractions.
- Calculate fractions of amounts.
- Plot coordinates in all four quadrants.
- Translate and reflect shapes.
