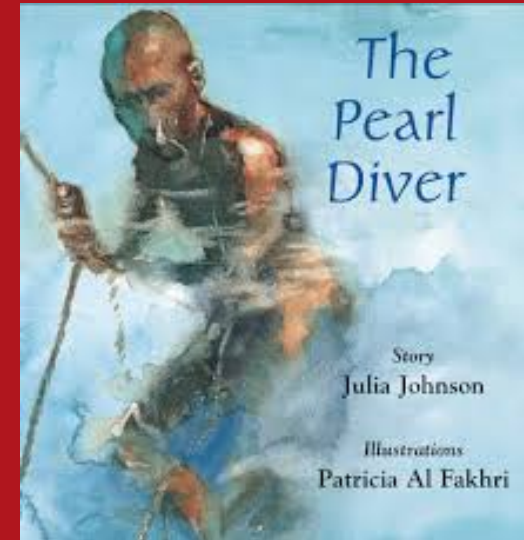

Have you got what it takes to become a Mexican chief?





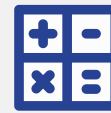
As writers, we will:

- Go on an adventure with our main character, 'Michael' as he begins his sailing adventure around the world.
- Use effective figurative language to describe a setting.
- Use appropriate sentence structures to create atmosphere.
- Use relative clauses to develop character descriptions.
- Include ambitious, high-level vocabulary in our writing.
- Evaluate our own work, enabling us to make the needed edits to improve.



As readers, we will:

- Practise reading with great expression, showing awareness of the listener.
- Retrieve and record information from the text.
- Draw inferences about a character's thoughts, feelings and motives.
- Discuss and evaluate the authors use of language.
- Use evidence from the text to analyse character feeling.



As mathematicians, we will:

- Identify and compare numbers up to 10,000,000.
- Solve problems using written methods of addition and subtraction.
- Multiply and divide 2-digit numbers by 4-digit numbers.
- Use the rule of BODMAS.
- Identify squared, cubed and prime numbers.
- Identify common factors and multiples.
- Order and compare fractions.



As scientists we will :

- Explain and investigate how light travels.
- Investigate reflection and refraction.
- Investigate and explain how aspects of light can be absorbed.
- Investigate and explain how shadows are formed.
- Describe and evaluate our findings in a conclusion.



In computing we will:
