As design and technologists we will:

- Designing a Viking shield and helmet.
- Plan and select the correct tools and equipment
- Create our designs at home using our plan.

As geographers we will:

- Identify and research about different types of settlements that the Vikings used.
- Research UAE traders and Ibn Battuta
- Explore the history of trading in the UAE

As historians we will:

- Research the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England.
- Understanding how the Vikings lived.
- Plotting a timeline of key events in Viking history
- Investigate the Viking raids and invasions.
- Identify who Edward the Confessor was.
- Explore Viking raids and invasions

As scientists we will:

- Explore the anatomy of a human tooth.
- Identify the names of the different teeth and their functions.
- Compare human and animal teeth.
- Investigate what tooth decay is.
- Name the organs and their functions of the digestive
- Construct and interpret variety of food chains. Identify producers, predators and prey.

High Performance Learning

We will design and create our own Viking shields and helmets. test. evaluate and improve them then use them as we participate in Viking day.

As readers we will:

- Read a range of extracts from legend stories.
- Identify themes through a selection of texts.
- Predict what will happen in a legend story using pictorial clues as well as information stated or implied.
- Participate in discussion based around a texts.
- Answer and begin to ask our own questions based on what we have read.
- Develop our dictionary skills to check the meaning of unfamiliar words.
- Discuss words and phrases that authors have used in a text that capture our interest.
- Discuss our opinions and thoughts about a text we have
- Listen and respond to our peers during discussions based around a text.

As mathematicians we will:

- Find 1000 more or less than a given number.
- Compare 4-digit numbers and explain the value of each
- Order 4-digit numbers.
- Round to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
- Solve problems involving rounding.
- To count backwards through zero.
- To add and subtract 4-digit numbers using the column method.
- To add and subtract 4-digit numbers with exchanging.
- To use the inverse operation to check answers.
- To select appropriate strategies to solve problems.

As users of technology we will:

- Identify how to stay safe online
- How to keep our information private online
- How to identify which websites we can trust
- Identifying when something might be fake and how we can fact check

As citizens' of the UAE we will:

- Understand the importance of the location of the Arabian Gulf
- Learn about the role of the Arabian Peninsula in the development of the ancient world.
