


# Growing and Changing

We will focus on writing non fiction stories using a range of tricky words that are spelt correctly. We will continue to focus on using capital letters, full stops, capital letters and finger spaces correctly. We will create our own character descriptions.

#### Mathematics:

We will be focusing on volume and capacity. We will learn the correct vocabulary to describe these concepts and encouraged to use them in our play. We will also revise the key concepts taught throughout the year to ensure we are fully prepared for our transition into Year I.

### Understanding the World:

We will be building our understanding of the world through looking at the life cycles of different plants and animals. We will be discussing growing up and our aspirations of what we want to be when we grow up. We will talk about the changes coming up in our lives, such as moving to Year I, moving school/house/country.
