- Students should attain a minimum of 5 International GCSE/IGCSEs at grades 4 - 9 including English and Mathematics.
- Students should attain a 7 or above at International GCSE/IGCSE level in the subjects intended to study at International AS/A level.
- Students applying from a curriculum other than the National Curriculum for England will be assessed against relevant criteria/standards.

- Students must choose a minimum of three International A Level/BTEC courses. Students are not permitted to study more than two BTEC courses as part of their options.

- Arab and non-Arab Muslim students must take Islamic Education as a compulsory subject. Ministry of Education Arabic as a first language is compulsory for students who are registered in the school/KHDA under an Arab passport. Arab students must also take Arabic in Option 5.
- The International A level and BTEC options chosen are **conditional**, based upon awarded International GCSE/GCSE results (or results from other curricular).
