

Drop-off zones and parking at GFS

Before you leave the house remember to take the temperature of your child(ren). **Stay at home if they show any signs of COVID-19**; such as fever (37.5°C or above), cough, body ache, fatigue, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, diarrhoea, nausea, headache, loss of sense of smell or taste.

Make sure your child(ren) have enough food and water for the whole day, and that they carry their personal hygiene bag with them every day (hand sanitiser, spare masks, disinfectant wipes, labelled sandwich bags).

- Access to the school building is not permitted.
- Parents/guardians can only enter the school building by prior appointment and only under exceptional circumstances.
- Time spent in the drop-off areas is limited to a maximum of 10 minutes.
- Masks must be worn and social distancing of 2 meters must be maintained at all times whilst on the school premises.
- Only one family member or a guardian is allowed to drop-off and pick-up.
- People with compromised medical conditions, including the elderly, should not come for drop-off and pick-up.

Drop-off and pick-up procedure – FS, Y1 and Y2

Gates will open at 7am. The national anthem will play at 7:40, and students will need to be in their classroom before 7:45 to be considered on time.

FS parents can enter through gate one and either park or drop-off their child outside the FS reception. If you park, please drop your child(ren) off in the FS outdoor play area where they will met by their teacher. If you drop your child(ren) off outside the FS reception, they should walk into the FS outdoor play area to meet their teacher. As the children enter the building, they will pass a thermal scanner.

FS students can be collected by a single parent/carer from the FS outdoor play area.


Y1 and 2 parents can enter through gate one and either park or drop-off their child outside the main reception. If you park, please drop your child(ren) off in the MUGA courts where they will met by their teacher. If you drop your child(ren) off outside the main reception, they should walk into the MUGA courts to meet their teacher. As the children enter the building, they will pass a thermal scanner.

Y1 and 2 students can be collected by a single parent/carer from the MUGA courts at 2:20 p.m.

Take advantage of the 45 minute drop-off time and come early to avoid queues and delays. Please be considerate and patient during peak times. Proper queueing enables more efficient and effective traffic flow.

Drop-off and pick-up procedure – Y3 to Y13

Gates will open at 7am. The national anthem will play at 7:40, and students will need to be in their classroom before 7:45 to be considered on time. Take advantage of the 45 minute drop-off time and come early to avoid queues and delays.

Y3 to Y13 parents can drop-off at the back of the school. Use the designated drop-off zone, and keep to the left to allow other vehicles to pass you on the right. Please make sure your children have their bags in their hands and are ready to exit the car quickly and safely on the side of the pavement. Waiting and parking are not permitted in the drop-off zone. Y3 to Y13 parents will not be permitted to park during drop-off as pedestrian access for parents via gate 3 and 3b is restricted.

Y3 to Y13 students will enter the premises through gate 3b and enter the school building through the primary canteen. The primary canteen is equipped with a thermal scanner. All students entering through gate 3b must pass through this in order to get access to the school. Once through the scanner, students can access the school through doors leading off the primary play area.

Y3 to 13 students must be collected by a single parent/carer, from the **MUGA courts at 2.20 p.m**. Parents will be permitted to enter the school premises via gate 3b for pick-up. Older students (Year 10 and above) may leave the school site independently with prior notification from their parents regarding their pick-up arrangements.
