#### 1. Introduction

The pupils at GEMS Founders School recognise their involvement and responsibilities as citizens of the global community whilst critically examining their own principles and attitudes.

We embrace this global dimension and will appreciate the similarities between people all over the world and at the same time celebrate the diversity within the UAE.

#### 2. Purpose of policy

The School curriculum compliments the rich and varied cultural heritage and ethnic diversity which we hold in our own community and the outside world. The National Curriculum for England as well as the Mistry Education, UAE, requirements embrace internationalism throughout the content and coverage.

The global dimension is reflected in the day to day attitudes and values of our pupils, the ethos of the school and is embedded in the short term planning of all curriculum areas.

The GEMS Founders School International Policy will thereby demonstrate the commitment, dedication and support of the school leaders, staff, parents and students for the global dimension.

#### 3. Aims and objectives

#### We will:

- a. Promote the value of foreign languages by showing our own strong belief in the value of all languages and the cultural concept behind them. We will honour the multicultural linguistic
  traditions and beliefs represented in our school, local and national communities.
  - b. Engage in regular communication with pupils and adults living in other countries to cultivate and fully develop partnerships worldwide. This will be done by:
    - letter writing, emailing, blogging and video conferencing with pupils elsewhere
    - interacting regularly with visitors from other countries
    - visits to places of cultural global interest in Dubai and abroad
    - pupil exchanges and ultimately foreign work experience placements
    - help pupils understand complex international interdependencies in the global economy and invite outside agencies to facilitate this where possible
  - c. To create opportunities for our pupils to exercise pupil voice in local, national and international contexts empowering them to participate in discussions of global relevance.
  - d. To engage our whole school community in the process of constant self-evaluation on the global dimension in order to reflect on our provision of the global ethos in our teaching and learning.

- e. Working with membership organisations such as Duke of Edinburgh (GFS is an International Award Centre) COBIS and BSME (GFS is a fully accredited organisation of both bodies) and the wider GEMS Education Network of schools in order to offer opportunities for our students
- f. A commitment towards a Twinning project is in place with the aim to find at least 2 school in the world to work closely with by 2022.
